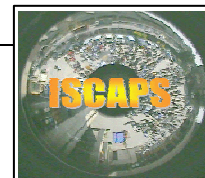




ISCAPS

Integrated Surveillance of Crowded Areas for Public Security



In March 2004, the European Commission launched a three-year Preparatory Action with a budget of €15 million for 2004 and €25 million for 2005 and 2006*. The first call for proposals closed on 23 June 2004 and surpassed expectations. ISCAPS was one of the proposals selected for funding. The project officially started on 1 February 2005.

ISCAPS Project

The main goal of ISCAPS is to reinforce security for the European citizens and to downsize the terrorist threat by reducing the risks of malicious events. This will be undertaken by providing efficient, real-time, user-friendly, highly automated surveillance of crowded areas that are significantly exposed to terrorist attacks.

This two-year Project has the main objectives to promote technological surveillance research guided by a system approach in order to bring research to maturity and to validate it in existing sites.
